

## Le présent en be + -ing

autrefois appelé "présent continu"/"présent progressif"

Regardez cette image:



- What **are** they **doing**? (Que sont-ils en train de faire?)
- They **are playing** football. (Ils jouent au football).

**Principal emploi:** action en cours au moment où l'on parle.

**Syntaxe:** Auxiliaire BE (conjugué au présent) + Verbe en -ing

**Exemple:**

I **am playing** football.

You **are playing** football.

He/She/It **is playing** football.

We **are playing** football.

You **are playing** football.

They **are playing** football.

**Négation:** I **am not playing** football, you **are not playing** football...

**Question:** Am I **playing** football? Are you **playing** football? Is he **playing** football? ...

**Réponses:**

**Are they playing football?**

Réponses longues:	Yes, they're playing football.	No, they aren't playing football.
Réponse courte:	Yes, they are.	No, they aren't.
